

# MOLINARO ISSUES 2013 ANNUAL REPORT TO LEGISLATURE

**Poughkeepsie, NY ...** Dutchess County Executive Marcus J. Molinaro has submitted the Annual Report for 2013 to the Dutchess County Legislature pursuant to the requirements of the Dutchess County Charter.

County Executive Molinaro stated, “As we continue our multi-year transformation of county government, we are focused on our ongoing efforts to reduce the overall cost of government while delivering quality core services to our residents. It is important, however, to pause sometimes to reflect back on the work that has been done and the outcomes that have been achieved. County employees have been asked to continue to do more with less and they have done so.
